WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

- Remove yourself and nearby occupants from
- Turn off hazardous equipment, make a final immediate danger.
- Raise The Alarm, notify nearby staff member, check of the room and shut door, and other classrooms.





SHELTER-IN-PLACE

Upon becoming aware of a storm or external emergency

- Move inside away from windows and items
- Remain inside and await further instruction that may fall.
- safe to do so Planned lessons may continue indoors where from the Chief Warden.

Once the storm has passed or emergency

situation is over.

- situations in your area: Notify the Chief Warden of dangerous
- If flooding has occurred, avoid pools of water.



EVACUATE

Whoop... Whoop... Whoop... or discovering an internal emergency On hearing the evacuation tone or instructed to leave the building:

- Turn off any equipment that may become a hazard if left unattended
- Commence Evacuation via the nearest safe
- Make a final check of the room and shut the
- Lead students to the ASSEMBLY AREA
- Officer report any problems to the Communications Account for your current class group and
- Remain in control of your class group at the ASSEMBLY AREA. Do not re-enter building responding Emergency Services Personnel until advised by the Chief Warden or

Wardens, IF NOT IN THE ACT OF TEACHING report to the nearest Area Control Point



LOCKDOWN

Upon becoming aware of an external the Lockdown Music: threatening incident to life or hearing

- Move inside to a secure area.
- down out of sight. Lock all doors and windows, draw blinds and get
- them from peering through windows or doors Direct students to sit on the floor together, prevent
- Give students reassurance to help students
- remain quiet and calm
- Wait for further instruction from a Warden
